

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE LINN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS LINN COUNTY COURTHOUSE – ROOM 200

TUESDAY, JANUARY 30, 2024

The Linn County Board of Commissioners met for the regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, January 30, 2024.

Those present at various times for the matters as indicated below were: Todd Noble, Linn County Health Services Administrator; Torri Lynn, Linn County Juvenile Department Director; Wayne Mink, Linn County Roadmaster; Michelle Hawkins, Linn County Treasurer; Stacey Whaley, Linn County Parks and Recreation Director; Steve Wills, Linn County Planning and Building Department Director, Gene Karandy, County Attorney for Linn County and Alex Paul, Linn County Communications Officer.

- 1, 2, 3. At 9:30 a.m. Chair Nyquist called the meeting to order. The flag salute and roll call followed. Commissioners Roger Nyquist, Chair; Will Tucker, Vice-Chair and Commissioner Sherrie Sprenger were present, as well as, Darrin Lane, Linn County Administrative Officer and Courtney Leland, Recorder for the Board of Commissioners.
- 4. Approval of Agenda.

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to approve the agenda. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Approval of the January 23, 2024 Commissioners' Meeting Minutes.

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to approve the January 23, 2024 Commissioners' Meeting Minutes. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.

7. Health Department – Todd Noble, Linn County Health Services Administrator.

Mr. Noble discussed that his predecessor had been working on this Amendment for over a decade.

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to approve Resolution & Order 2024-027. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.

8. Juvenile Department - Torri Lynn, Linn County Juvenile Department Director.

A. Resolution & Order 2024-026 approving an Amendment No. 2 to an Intergovernmental Agreement for the Youth Development Division between the State of Oregon Department of Education and Linn County and delegating authority to execute originals.

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to approve Resolution & Order 2024-026. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.

9. Road Department - Wayne Mink, Linn County Roadmaster.

A. Resolution & Order 2024-018 accepting a petition to vacate a portion of a County road, Wirth Road (County Road 416).

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to approve Resolution & Order 2024-018. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.

B. Roadmaster's Report regarding a petition to vacate a portion of Wirth Road.

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to accept the Roadmaster's Report regarding a petition to vacate a portion of Wirth Road. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.

C. Resolution & Order 2024-019 vacation of a portion of a County road, Wirth Road (County Road 416).

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to approve Resolution & Order 2024-019. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.

Action – Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Sprenger seconded the motion to approve Resolution 2024-029. The vote was called. The motion passed unanimously.
