Board Summaries for March 15, 2022

R&O 2022-054

This is a Personal Services Agreement between Linn County and Family Tree Nursery to provide Correction Peer Recovery Mentors. Peer Recovery Mentors will provide mentoring and transitional integration services to Corrections and Drug Court clients with addiction issues in order to support their addiction and recovery and assist them in successfully integrating into the community. This agreement is in effect from July 1, 2021 to June 31, 2023 for a not to exceed amount of \$100,921.00. This agreement is for pass thru funds from the Criminal Justice Commission **Specialty Courts Grant Program Grant Agreement**.

R&O 2022-077

This is a Personal Services Agreement between Linn County and ABC House to provide Victim Support Services. The agreement is in effect from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2023 for an amount not to exceed \$89,871.50. This agreement is pass thru funds from the Criminal Justice Commission Justice Reinvestment Grant Program Grant Agreement.

R&O 2022-078

This is a Personal Services Agreement between Linn County and Center Against Rape and Domestic Violence (CARDV) to provide Victim Support Services. The agreement is in effect from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2023 for an amount not to exceed \$89,871.50. This agreement is pass thru funds from the Criminal Justice Commission Justice Reinvestment Grant Program Grant Agreement.

R&O 2022-081

This is a Personal Services Agreement between Linn County and Family Tree Nursery to provide Correction Peer Recovery Mentors. Peer Recovery Mentors will provide mentoring and transitional integration services to Corrections and Drug Court clients with addiction issues in order to support their addiction and recovery and assist them in successfully integrating into the community. This agreement is in effect from July 1, 2021 to June 31, 2023 for a not to exceed amount of \$290,730.00. This agreement is for pass thru funds from the Criminal Justice Commission **Justice Reinvestment Grant Program Grant Agreement**.

R&O 2022-091

This is an Intergovernmental agreement between Linn County and Department of Human Services to rent 262 dedicated square feet and 118 square feet of common area for a total of 380 square feet.
