- Resolution 2022-353 authorizes the County Park's Director to apply for a grant from the Oregon State Parks & Recreation Department (OPRD) County Opportunity Grant Fund Program to help pay for to pay for the construction of an RV waste disposal facility on County owned property in Sweet Home. OPRD would fund 50% of the project and the County Parks would fund the remaining 50% with a combination of dedicated County Park's funds, TLT and State Grant funds. No County General Funds will be used to fund the project.
 - The Parks Department has been struggling with RV waste system failures at Sunnyside Park for the past 5 years, as well as, exceeding DEQ waste strength permit level at River Bend County Park. County Park's staff is concerned that we will eventually have to close down the Sunnyside and possibly the River Bend County Park RV Waste disposal sites, due to failure to meet permit limits and /or failure of the RV waste systems there. The proposed Sweet Home RV waste disposal facility would provide connection to the City of Sweet Home's sewage treatment facility, which would provide a permanent solution for disposal of RV wastewater for all of the camping facilities in east Linn County.
