Agreement

- Resolution 2023-099 –authorizes the signing a grant agreement with the Oregon State Parks & Recreation Department (OPRD) County Opportunity Grant Fund Program to help pay for the construction of an RV waste disposal facility on County owned property in Sweet Home. This is a 50-50 matching grant; the total cost of the project is \$710,258. OPRD will reimburse the County \$355,129 and the County Parks Department will match the grant with a combination of County Parks force account (staff labor) and funding from the TLT, RV and Forest Funds. No County General Funds will be used to fund the project.
 - The Parks Department has been struggling with RV waste system failures at Sunnyside Park for the past 5 years, as well as, exceeding DEQ waste strength permit level at River Bend County Park. County Park's staff is concerned that we will eventually have to close down the Sunnyside and possibly the River Bend County Park RV Waste disposal sites, due to failure to meet permit limits and /or failure of the RV waste systems there. The proposed Sweet Home RV waste disposal facility would provide connection to the City of Sweet Home's sewage treatment facility, which would provide a permanent solution for disposal of RV wastewater for all of the camping facilities in east Linn County.

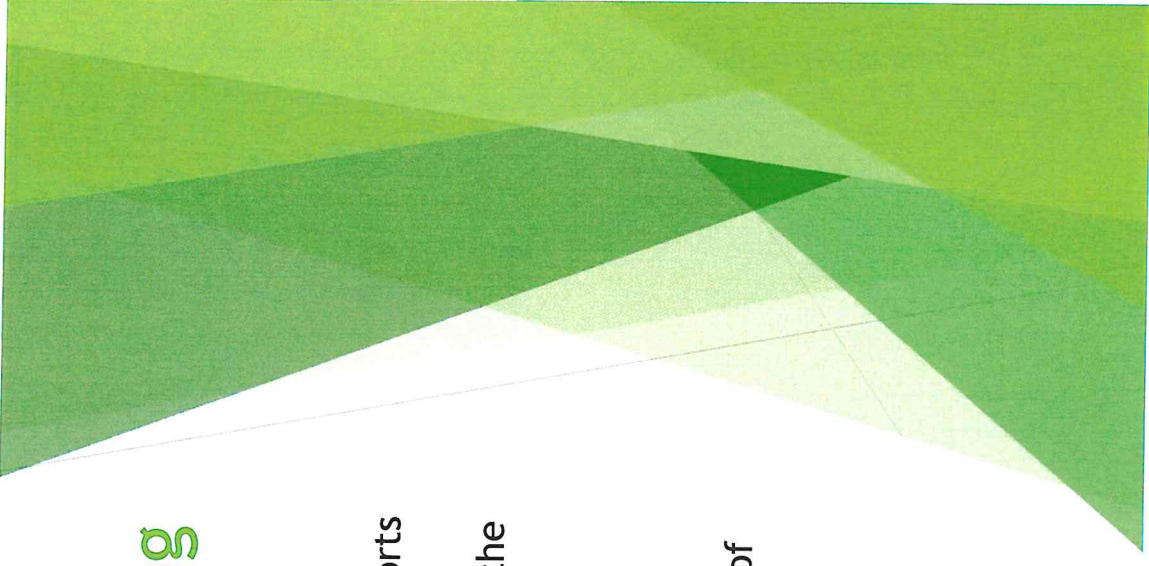

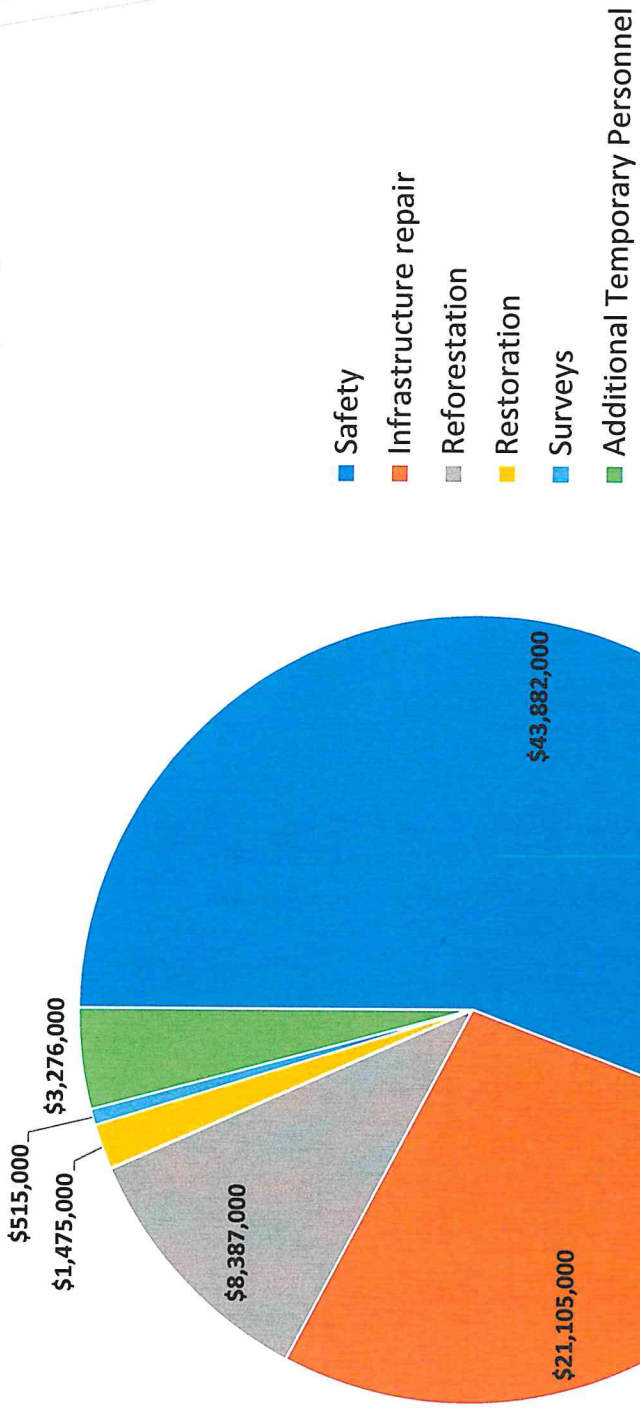
- ▶ Congress appropriated ~\$1 Billion for Forest Service Disaster Recovery Efforts Nationally in the FY21 Continuing Resolution.
- ▶ Of that, Region 6 was allocated approximately \$250 million largely due to the unprecedented wildfires of 2020.
- ▶ Conditions for this funding are that the event occurred between 2019 and 2021 and are a response to declared emergencies such as fires, floods, snowstorms, etc.
- ▶ In December 2021, the Willamette was given an initial planning allocation of \$53 million by the Regional Office and asked to develop a recovery project list.
- ▶ Willamette National Forest leadership asked staff to compose a list of recovery needs to get an initial basis for the scope of recovery work



Disaster Supplemental Recovery Funding

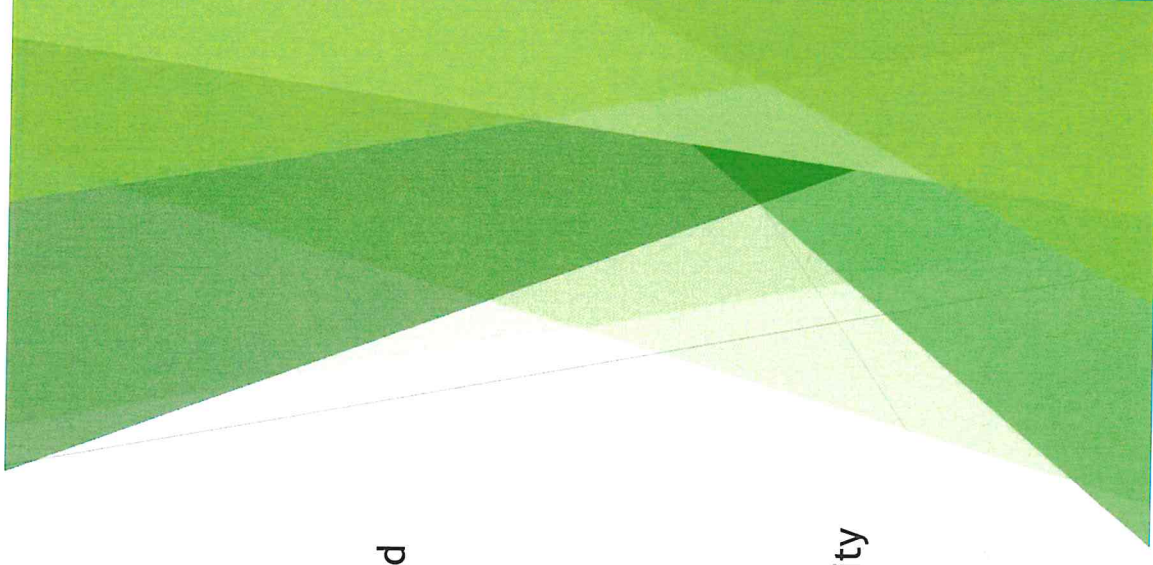
- ▶ Over \$100 million in recovery projects were identified on the Willamette; far more than the \$53 million planning allocation. In addition, this number was expected to increase as FS staff continued to gain access to areas of the fire.
- ▶ Willamette Leadership decided to focus on fire recovery projects and prioritized the remaining projects focusing on critical needs:
 - ▶ Public Safety and Access
 - ▶ Infrastructure
 - ▶ Reforestation and planting of high severity burn areas
 - ▶ Restoration
 - ▶ Additional survey needs
 - ▶ Other
- ▶ The Final Disaster Recovery Budget Allocation for the Willamette was \$78,640,000.

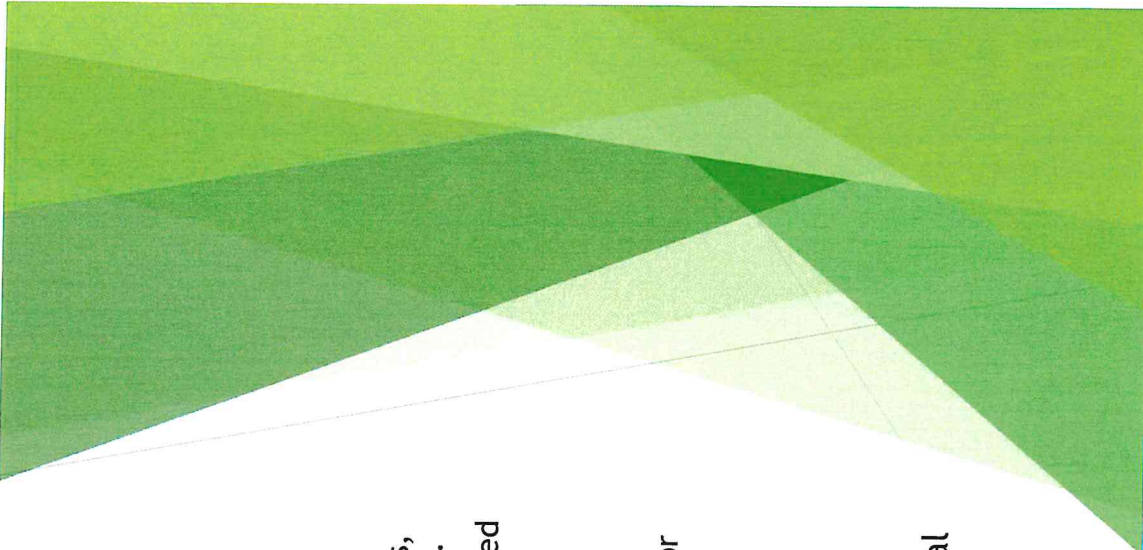
**Distribution of Disaster Relief Funds by project type RECEIVED on the

Developing a Dedicated Team for Disaster Recovery

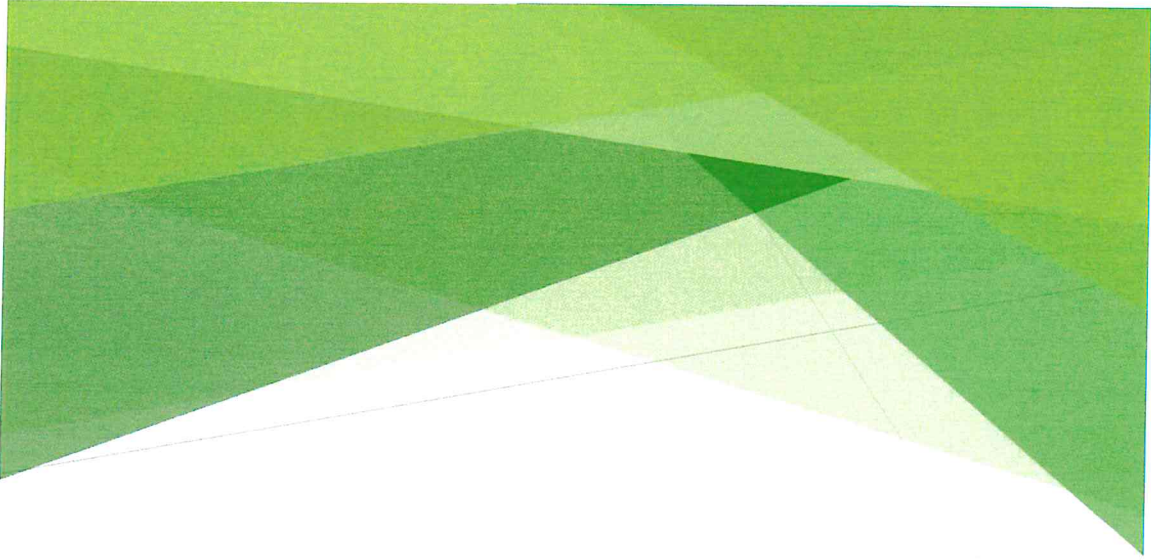
- ▶ Leadership identified the need for a dedicated team to help coordinate and implement the large disaster recovery workload.
- ▶ This team consists of four permanent staff and six temporary (3-4 years) staff.
- ▶ All permanent staff have been hired as of January 2023 and offers are currently in progress for the temporary staff.
- ▶ Duties include: Coordination, budget tracking, contract and agreement development, contract implementation, monitoring, etc.
- ▶ It is important to note that these recovery projects are not exempt from standard federal regulations and policies and still require additional capacity from Forest personnel to complete NEPA, Endangered Species Act Consultations, Heritage consultations, engineering designs, etc.





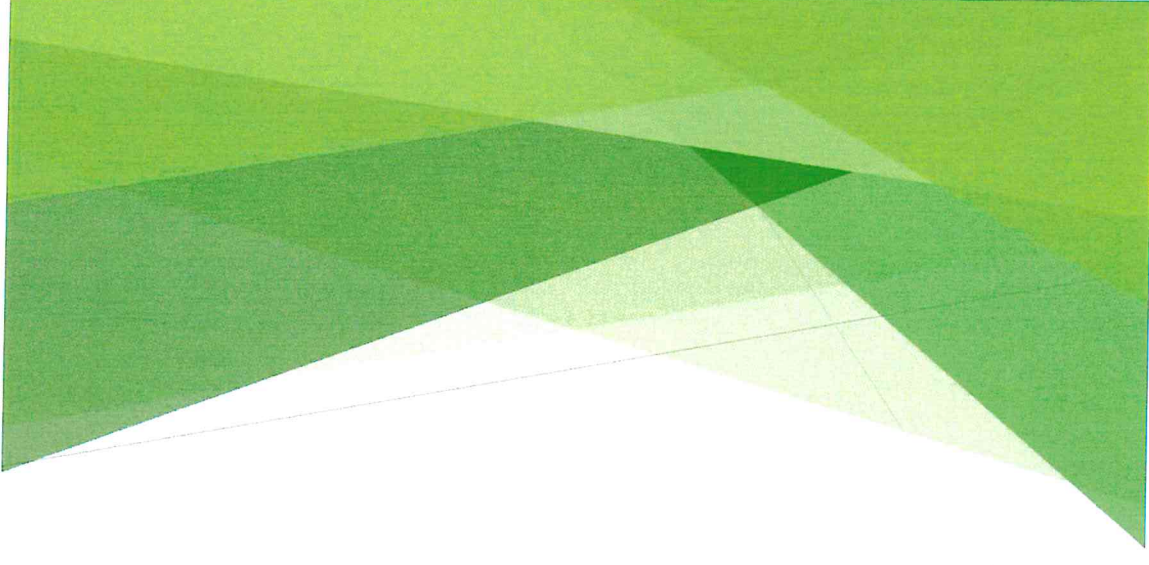
Priority Program of Work

- ▶ One of the highest priority Disaster Recovery projects is to implement the 2020 Fire Affected Roads Risk Reduction EA.
 - ▶ This project will remove danger trees within 1 tree height of the road, reduce fuel loading to Forest Plan Standards, treat invasive weeds, reconstruct fire damaged roads, and increase culvert sizes to accommodate the additional flows resulting from the fire.
 - ▶ Public safety and access on the priority road network is expected to be greatly improved on 250 miles of road across the Forest.
 - ▶ Integrated Resource Stewardship Contracts (IRSC) will be utilized to conduct this work and will allow for a large array of projects to be embedded within scope of work.
 - ▶ The roads treated within this project will also provide Potential Control Lines (PCLs) for future fires or reburns.
- ▶ The rebuild of the Detroit compound housing is also a priority project. This housing is being built in cooperation with local industries by means of new wood utilization technologies and will serve as a model for future construction.
- ▶ Several large scale engineering projects are currently being put into contracts and/or agreements. The FS is utilizing agreements with local industry and Federal Highways to complete over \$3.5 million in road improvements.

 - ▶ Holiday Farm Fire Affected Roads Risk Reduction (\$5.2 million)
 - ▶ Beachie/Lionshead Fire Affected Roads Risk Reduction (\$20 million)
 - ▶ Gales Fire Affected Roads Risk Reduction (\$7 million)
 - ▶ Detroit Housing Reconstruction (\$9 million)
 - ▶ McKenzie River Priority Road Reconstruction (\$5 million)
 - ▶ **Numerous other recovery projects including reforestation, trail reconstruction, trail bridge replacement, infrastructure repair, reservoir debris**

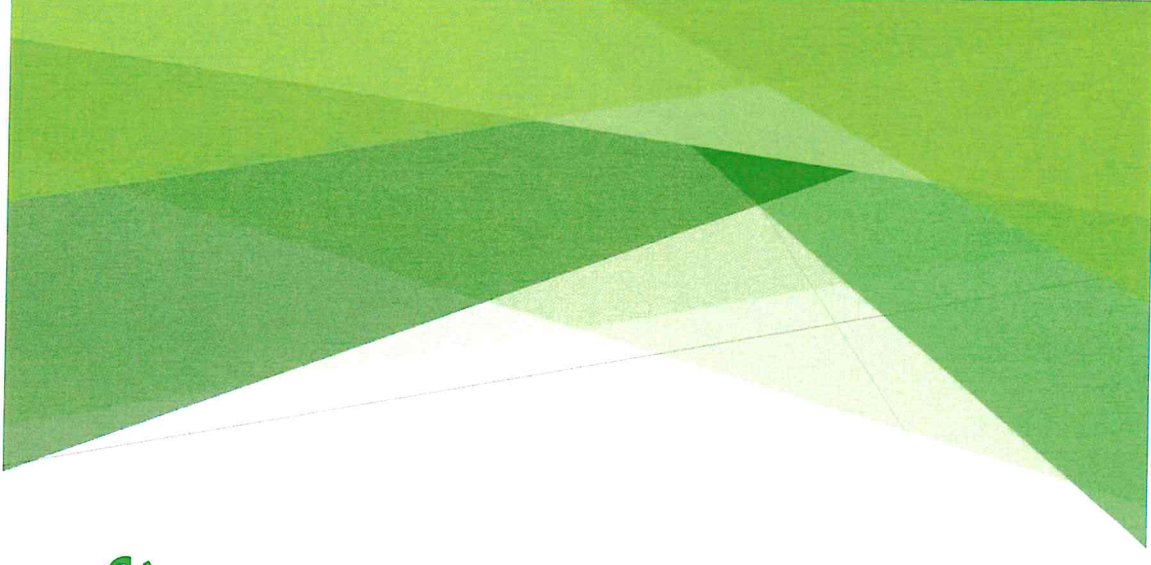
Managed Fire in the Wilderness

- There is no let burn policy
- The Willamette National Forest has no plans to allow natural fires to burn
- The reality is that Wilderness Areas are difficult places to fight fire



Fuels Management on the Willamette

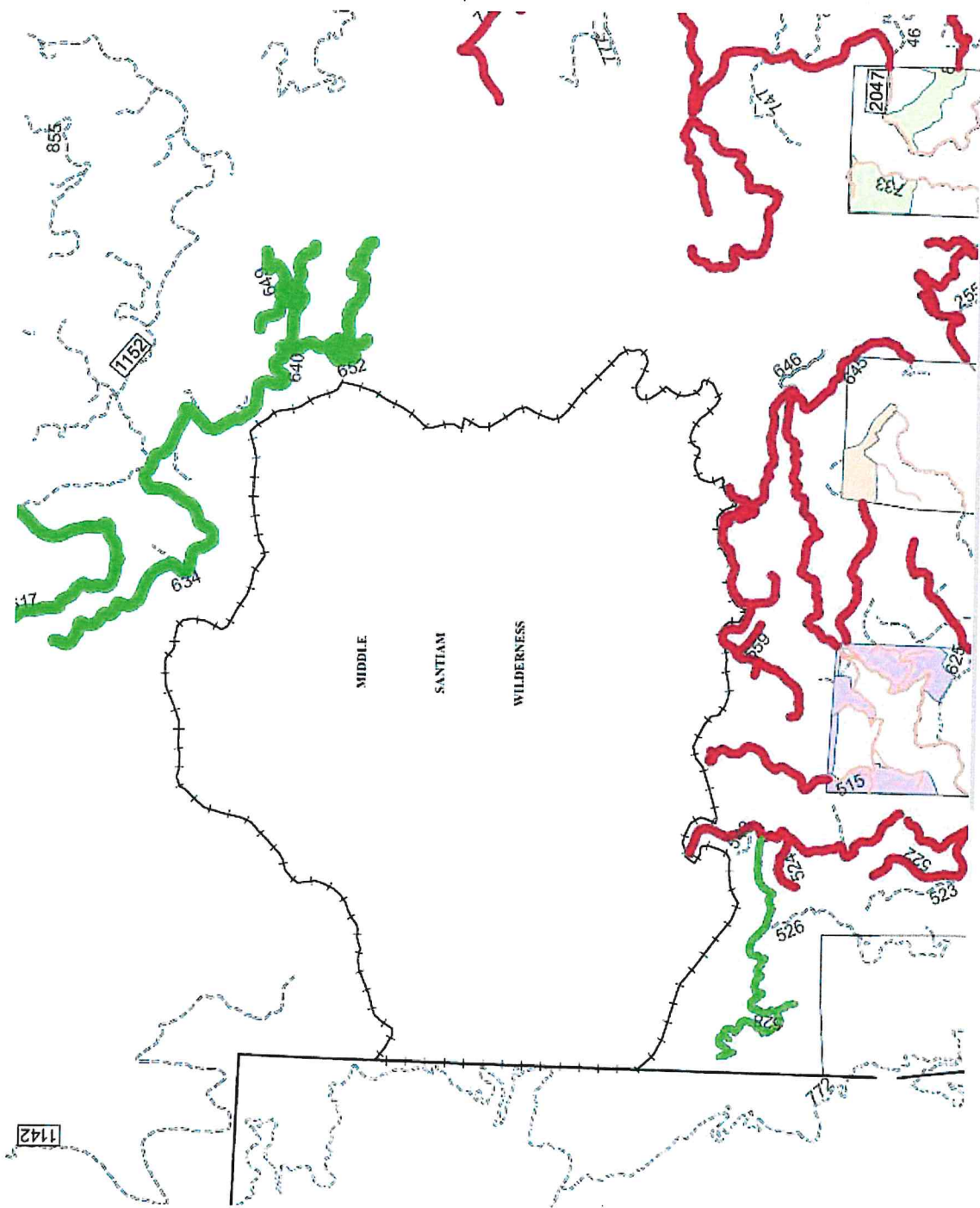
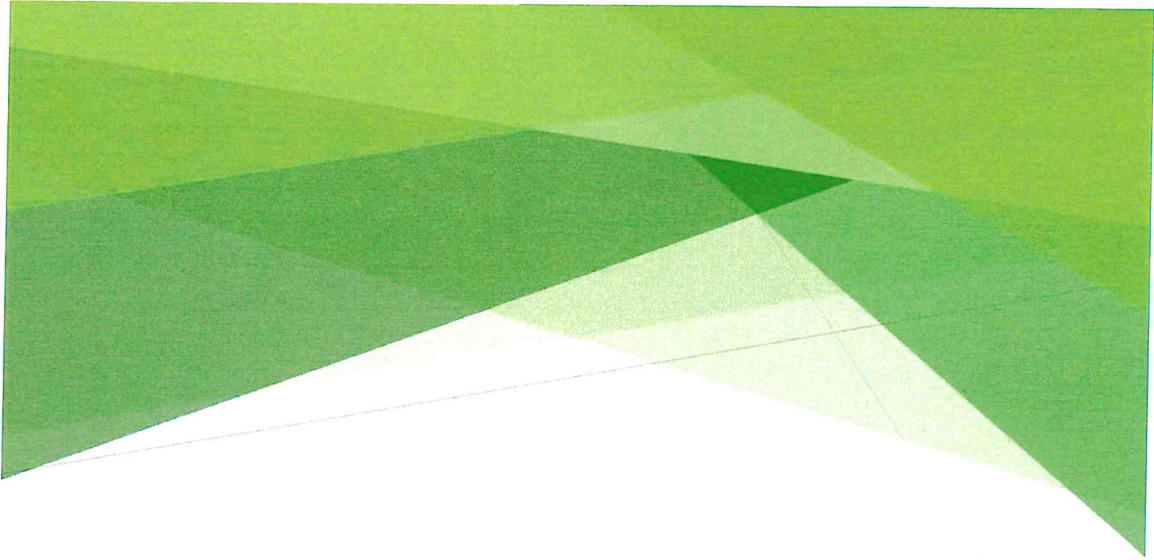
- Past fuels work on the Willamette has been heavily focused on post-timber sale slash reduction.
- With the increase in fire activity of across the Forest in recent years we are beginning to pivot to fuels driving some of our projects vs being a connected action.
- We are currently developing Potential Operational Delineations (PODs) to look at the landscape from a fire and fuels perspective and examine where we have values at risk as well as areas that are more difficult to fight fire in.
- Also looking at where our partners are doing similar work so that we can work together on adjacent acres (collaborative groups, private landowners, other agencies).
- While the Willamette is not currently a national priority fire landscape we are beginning to see additional funding and investments from the regional office and an understanding of the fire risk on the Forest.



Fuels Projects in Linn County

Focus on concerns around Middle Santiam Wilderness

- Annual meetings to talk about strategies and realities with Giustina Resources and Cascade Timber Consulting.
- Have plans to compliment work being done on private with similar work on the Sweet Home Ranger District.
- Anticipate completing 5 miles of Potential Control Line work in 2023.
- Additional work planned for 2024 and beyond. Looking at a 5-10 year program of work for the Forest.



Preseason Preparedness

- Hiring ongoing right now for Fire Staff Officer. The majority of our current critical vacancies are in our Dispatch Center. We are developing plans to add temporary help to support dispatch during the summer.
- Anticipate fire resources being fully staffed for the summer. May have some additional resource capacity next year with 20 person crews going to 25 people.
- Interagency Fire School with the Oregon Department of Forestry will happen again this year at Sweet Home. Last three years each agency has done their own training.
- Expect to have the same amount of aviation resources available this year as last year. No current plans to have prepositioned aircraft but will have detection ships available and helicopter support available as conditions develop during fire season.
