As an addendum to my application for a permit to construct, alter or repair an on-site sewage disposal system, I am requesting approval to install the septic tank and use it as a temporary holding tank in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule 340-71-160(7). I am submitting the completed pumping contracts as required.

By my signature, I certify that I understand and agree to the following conditions.

- 1. The tank outlet must be sealed with a watertight seal, and an inspection of the tank installation performed before connection of plumbing to the tank.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the property owner to maintain the tank in a manner that precludes the discharge of sewage onto the ground surface.
- 3. I agree to allow representatives of the Linn County Environmental Health Program access to assess the status of the tank maintenance at any time.
- 4. The maximum length of time for which a septic tank can be used as a temporary holding tank is twelve months.
- 5. Failure to properly maintain the tank resulting in discharge of sewage is a violation of Oregon law and this agreement, and will result in enforcement action.
- Failure to satisfactorily complete the system, including the soil absorption system (drainfield) within the year in which this approval is in effect will constitute a violation of Oregon law and this agreement, and will result in enforcement action.
- 7. Any enforcement action initiated per numbers 5 or 6 above may involve a citation to appear in court and the assessment of a fine.
