COMES NOW, The Linn County Pioneer Association (Association) and respectfully makes application (Exhibit 1) to the Board of County Commissioners for Linn County (Board) seeking the Board's approval to close certain portions of a county road in the City of Brownsville for the purpose of conducting the annual Linn County Pioneer Picnic parades; and,

WHEREAS, The Board having now considered the request by the Association to use certain portions of a County Road in the City of Brownsville, being Main Street (County Road Number 0425) in conjunction with its annual Kiddie Parade on June 16, 2023, and Grand Parade on June 17, 2023; and being advised by the County Roadmaster; now, therefore, be it
