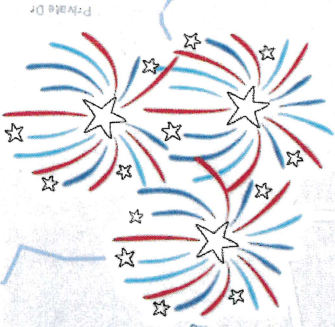

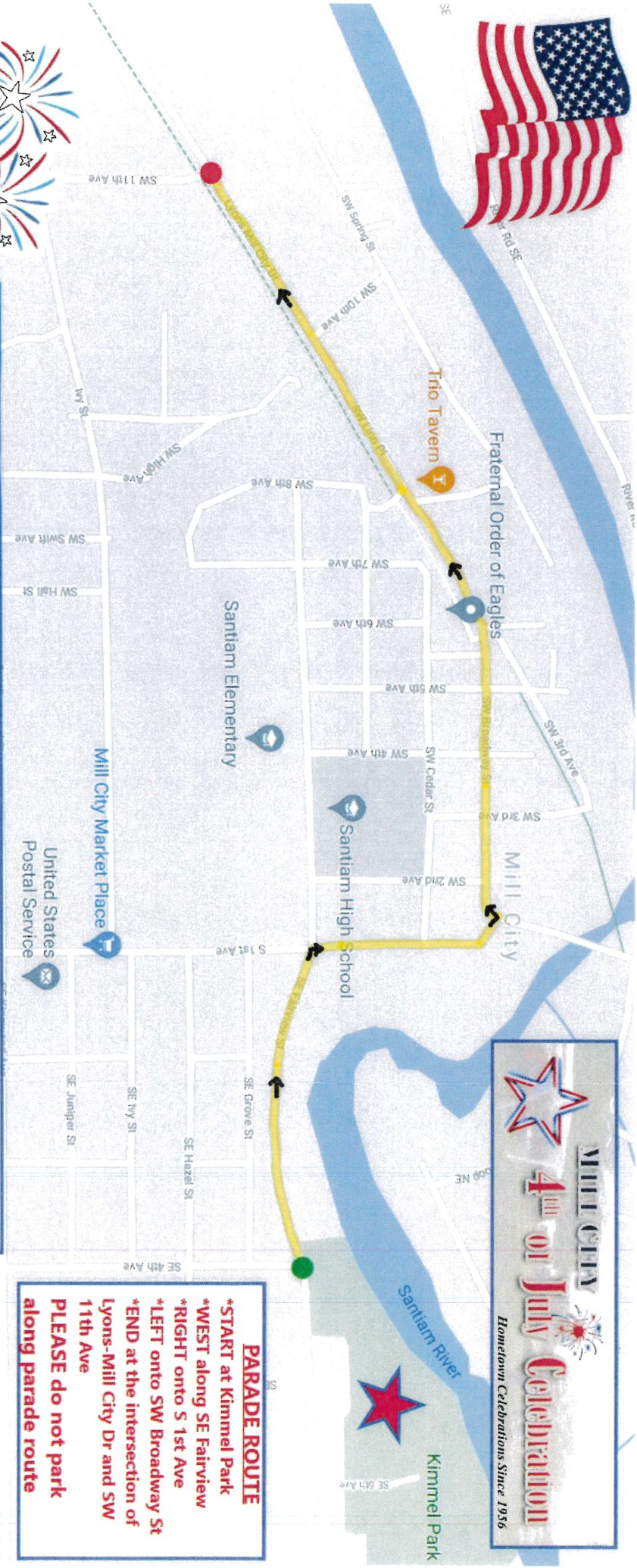
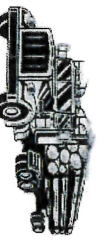

WHEREAS, The Board having now considered the request by the City of Mill City to use certain portions of county roads (First Avenue, SW Broadway Street, SW Linn Blvd. and Lyons Mill City Drive), in the City of Mill City in conjunction with its annual July Fourth Parade and related events on July 4, 2025, from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm and being advised by the County Roadmaster; and, now, therefore, be it



**RESOLVED**, That the application of Stacie Cook, City Recorder, City of Mill City, to close certain portions of First Avenue, SW Broadway Street, SW Linn Blvd. and Lyons Mill City Drive in the City of Mill City, as further described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto, be approved subject to the following conditions:


1. That the closure to vehicular traffic is limited from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm, July 4, 2025, for the formation, conduct, and disbanding of the annual July Fourth Parade; and




1 2. That the placement of the barricades and traffic control be subject to the direction of the Linn
